INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES

Our Services use cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Services.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer and/or mobile device if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive and/or mobile device.

Our cookies do not store sensitive or personal information, such as your name, address or card details. However, if you would like to restrict the level of cookies that are stored on your computer, you can use your browser to do this. However, you should be aware that doing so may impair our website and its functionality.

You should also be aware that clearing all cookies from your browser will also delete any cookies that are storing your preferences, for example, whether you have already accepted cookies on a website.

We use the following cookies:

Analytical/performance cookies. They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Services when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our Services works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

Here is a list of the cookies we use, and what they are used for:

- Google Analytics ((_gat, _ga, _gid, _gat, _gtag, _UA_*)) - these cookies collect information about how visitors use our website. This information is used to improve the site. All information is collected in anonymous form. Analytics sets cookies in order to evaluate your use of the website and compile reports for us on activity on the site. Google stores the information collected by the cookie on servers in the United States. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law, or where such third parties process the information on Google's behalf. Google will not associate your IP address with any other data held by Google. By using the website, you consent to the processing of data about you by Google in the manner and for the purposes set out above. - Session Identifier (PHPSESSID) - this session cookie is installed automatically. Used to store a unique random identifier for each visit to this website. No other information is written to this cookie on your computer/device.
- Cookie Consent (pview) - this cookie remembers whether the banner explaining our use of cookies has already been shown.

You block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies you will see a warning message.

All cookies, except for pview (stored for one year), PHPSESSID (stored for one month) and gid (stored for 24 hours) cookies, will expire after the browser window/session is ended.
