INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to make improvements to our website.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer and/or mobile device if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive and/or mobile device.

HOW ARE OUR COOKIES CATEGORISED?

The cookies we use can be categorised depending on their purpose:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website.
- **Analytical or performance cookies.** These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).
- **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests.
- **Persistent cookies:** these cookies remain on a user's device for the period of time specified in the cookie. They are activated each time that the user visits the website that created that particular cookie.
- **Session cookies:** these cookies allow website operators to link the actions of a user during a browser session. A browser session starts when a user opens the browser window and finishes when they close the browser window. Session cookies are created temporarily. Once you close the browser, all session cookies are deleted.

Cookies can also be distinguished as first-party cookies or third-party cookies.

- First-party cookies are allocated to the website that you visit.
- Third-party cookies come from a third-party, such as a web analytics program.

cppbnr1	Remembers whether an informational popup banner (e.g. specific to an urgent company announcement) has already been shown	Deletes at the end of the browsing session

- bcookie - Browser Identifier cookie to uniquely identify devices accessing LinkedIn to detect abuse on the platform;
- lang - Used to remember a user's language setting;
- li_gc - Used to store consent of guests regarding the use of cookies for non-essential purposes;
- li_mc - Used as a temporary cache to avoid database lookups for member's consent for use of non-essential cookies and used for having consent information on the client side to enforce consent on the client side;
- lidc - To optimize data center selection;
- lissc - Used to ensure there is correct SameSite attribute for all cookies in that browser;

- Ims_ads - Used to identify LinkedIn Members off LinkedIn in the Designated Countries for advertising;
- Ims_analytics - Used to identify LinkedIn Members in the Designated Countries for analytics;

Google

- 1P_JAR, ANID, NID - These cookies are used by Google to display personalized advertisements on Google sites, based on recent searches and previous interactions.
- DV, UULE - These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our website. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the website. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors, where visitors have come to the website from and the pages they visited. If you do not allow these cookies, we will not be able to include your visit in our statistics.
